The Outaouais Branch's Board of Directors has established a Nomination Committee for the 2021 Annual General Meeting (AGM) to be held on **April 22, 2021 from 10 a.m. to noon** via videoconferencing. Jacques Lambert, National Administrator of the District of Quebec, has accepted to Chair this committee. His mandate is to receive nominations for directorships, verify the eligibility of the suggested candidates, and preside over the election of new Branch Directors at the 2021 AGM.

The Board has eleven directorships, four of which are currently held. Pursuant to our bylaws, a Director is usually elected to the AGM for a two-year term. To allow continuity to the Board, six positions are subject to election in even years, and the other five positions in odd years. However, since there was no AGM in 2020 due to the pandemic, the mandate of all Directors was extended, by waiver, until the next AGM in 2021. As a result, all director positions will be subject to election at the April meeting. In order to restore the mandate rotation within the Board of 2021, candidates for directorships will be required to indicate on their Nomination Bulletin whether they would prefer to be elected for a one-year or two-year term.
