6. Little Brothers Needs Volunteers



<u>Little Brothers</u> needs trusted volunteers to listen, discuss and visit socially isolated people aged 75 and over. Come light up their lives! Across Quebec, we support nearly 2,500 seniors aged 75 and over who live completely alone ... without family or friends. We offer them a significant

presence that provides an essential sense of social belonging. 2,500 seniors supported is huge, but we know that there are more than 50,000 seniors in Quebec in this situation. We need to do more!

This significant social impact is achieved by our volunteers, supported by our team of regional coordinators. Being a volunteer for Les Petits Frères is also enriching, it gives even more meaning to life, and it can even serve to break one's own isolation. The schedule is flexible: 1 to 2 hours per week. We ask for a minimum of 6 months as a commitment, but our volunteers stay with us for an average of 6 years.

No experience or training is required, you just have to be caring, attentive and able to welcome others in the present moment. Each volunteer receives personalized training and support.
