# 2. NAFR Outaouais 30th Anniversary Banquet – Highlights and thanks.





### 8. Three Organizations Join Forces to Promote Two Gestures for Good Treatment for Seniors



La Commission des droits de la personne et des droits de la jeunesse launched a major awareness-raising operation for the well-being of seniors in collaboration with Le Regroupement québécois des residences pour aînés (RQRA) and le Réseau québécois des organismes sans but lucratif d'habitation (RQOH) through a campaign that promotes two messages: Please knock before

entering and Please explain the fees charged to me.

"Many seniors in seniors' residences (RPA) express dissatisfaction with the services that are billed to them without necessarily being very clear if they really need this service, if they really required it", explains Jacques Beaudoin, Director of Public and Legal Affairs at the RQOH. "Seniors receive services that evolve over time," says RQRA President and CEO, Marc Fortin: "It is important to clearly explain each new medication, each new treatment and each new cost".

The other much appreciated gesture: "Knock-knock, can I come in?" says CEO Marc Fortin. "Parents, friends, but also members of staff, in the heat of the moment, without any bad intentions, can sometimes enter without announcing themselves", explains director Jacques Beaudoin.

"These are two very simple gestures which are nevertheless among the main reasons for the dissatisfaction of people who live in RPAs, according to what the Commission has been able to observe in several regions of Quebec", indicates Philippe-André Tessier, President of the Commission. "With our two partners, we wanted to spread a positive campaign on good treatment, to help make us reflect, individually and collectively, on the way we interact with the elderly".

The RQRA and the RQOH combine 116,000 housing units in RPAs.
