- 3. Call the National office at 1-855-304-4700 and tell them you wish to pay your 2016 dues. Have member number and credit card ready.
- 4. Make a cheque payable to "National Association of Federal Retirees" and mail it to the National Office. Be sure to include your membership branch and number.
- 5. Visit the National office and pay the member dues personally.
