Our national membership numbers are 179,452 as reported at the Annual Members Meeting in June. Our Branch membership is 571 members. Down slightly. If you know of any Federal retiree or potential retiree please let them know about our Association. You can have them contact any member of the Branch executive for further information.

The 2018 dues rates have increased slightly. Dues are now \$48.96 for Singles and \$63.60 for Doubles. For those who have their dues deducted at source (DDS) no action is required.

For those who pay directly, there are many options available. They include:

- 1. Pay by cheque NAFR, Bluewater Branch and mail it to the branch's post office box.
- 2. Visit the Associations web site (www.federalretirees.ca) click on "joining us" and select "renew your membership" and follow the instructions.
- 3. Call the National office at 1-855-304-4700 and tell them you wish to pay your 2018 dues. Have member number ready.
- 4. Make a cheque payable to "National Association of Federal Retirees" and mail it to the National Office. Be sure to include your membership branch and number.
- 5. Visit the National office and pay the member dues personally.

One other thing to mention is that these dues payments are not tax deductible.
