Indexing 2019

I hope you are all enjoying the 2019 increase to our pensions of 2.2% which was announced late in 2018 and was applied to our pension payments in January 2019. Let's keep working together and advocating for the safety and security of our pension and indexing payments.

Annual General Meeting (AGM) – April 15, 2019

Motions

At the AGM this year we will be putting forward some financial motions including a multi-year motion concerning the Branch Defense of Benefit reserve fund. The motion will propose a three (3) year plan to remit to the national office a total of \$20,000 (\$10,000 in year 1 (2019); \$5,000 in year 2 (2020) and \$5,000 in year 3 (2021)). This money will help defer some of the costs associated with the National Advocacy campaign focused on the 2019 federal election and the appeal of the Public Service Health Care Plan federal court decision and other initiatives on behalf of the Association.

Board of Director Positions and Elections

We have several members of the Board of Directors for our Branch that will be vacating their positions on the Board. If you are interested in sitting on the Board, please contact the Branch email address or one of the current Board members to discuss this opportunity. We have an excellent mentoring and education process so don't be shy. It's a great opportunity to connect with fellow retirees, meet new people and get involved in issues that matter to us. Elections will be held at the end of the AGM business meeting.

As you can see from the information below, the National Office has already started the preparation for the election. We are a non-partisan organization and therefore will be interacting and advocating with candidates from all major parties.

Federal Election 2019 – Message sent out by the National Office and reprinted here

The next federal election is slated for October 21, 2019. For Federal Retirees, the election will be an exciting opportunity to advance our advocacy goals and to continue to build our grassroots network of advocates. And if done well – with a consistent message carried by members, volunteers, staff and supporters – our 2019 election campaign strategy will set the stage for our work with the next Parliament.

On February 20, Federal Retirees, along with eight other seniors-focused organizations,

launched our federal election advocacy campaign. We kicked things off with a lobby day on Parliament Hill and a reception with Senators and Members of Parliament co-hosted with the Minister of Seniors, Filomena Tassi. With this launch, Federal Retirees has outlined its priorities for the upcoming election.

In early May, branches will receive a package that includes an overview of each of these issues as well as a variety of tools to help you and your branch get started in planning your advocacy activities for the upcoming election. We will also send you hard copies of some of these materials in the mail.

2019 is poised to be demanding year, yet also exciting and full of possibility. While the political field will always shift, presenting new challenges, one thing is for certain – we could not do this work without the strength, dedication and enthusiasm of our branches, volunteers and members.
