# **Authority and Responsibility:**

The Board of Directors is the legal authority for the Winnipeg and District Branch of the National Association of Federal Retirees. As a member of the Board, the Past President acts in a position of trust to its members. The Past President will serve in a consultative capacity only and at the invitation of the President. This is a non-voting position.

# Requirements:

Requirements of Board membership include:

- 1. Commitment to the work of the organization.
- 2. Knowledge and skills in one or more areas of Board governance: policy, finance, programs, human resources, and advocacy.
- 3. Attendance at Board meetings.
- 4. Attendance at Annual General Meeting.
- 5. Support of special events.

### Term:

He/she will serve until such time as the President's term is concluded or at a time mutually acceptable.

### **General Duties:**

The Past President is responsible to be a resource to the President and 1<sup>st</sup> Vice-President. The Past President:

- 1. Provides support and acts as a resource to the President.
- 2. Assists the President in the performance of his/her duties whenever requested to do so.
- 3. Has no direct role in carrying out programs and services.
- 4. May serve as Chairperson of the Nominating Committee.

### **Review Date and Approval Date**

The Nominating Committee reviews the Past President's job description annually.

Recommended changes are presented to the Board.
